TIME OF UNCERTAINTY:

The safety net is essential to assist patients in navigating through the changes of the healthcare delivery system, as Federal initiatives regarding Affordable Care Act "repeal and replace" efforts could create additional healthcare access issues in lowa.

■ THE UN/UNDERINSURED:

Affordability remains an issue, with inadequate and/or unusable coverage that limits access due to out-of-pocket co-pays/deductibles/premiums, covered service limitations and/or benefit caps.

DETERMINANTS OF HEALTH:

Challenges in healthcare access may have little to do with insurability and much to do with making critical community connections for adequate food, clothing, housing, transportation and addressing patient education/health literacy issues.




The State of Iowa invests \$348,322 in its free clinics – the Return on Investment yields **\$6 for every \$1** invested.¹
